**MeSRob2025** aims to bring together researchers and practitioners dealing with multi-disciplinary aspects of medical and service robotics and applications in an intimate, collegial and stimulating environment. MeSRob2025 continues a successful series of workshops that has been started in 2012. The Conference will be held at the CNAM-IFMI building in the Faculty of Fundamental and Applied Sciences of the University of Poitiers. The previous sites of this Workshop series were Romania (2012), Serbia (2013), Switzerland (2014), France (2015), Austria (2016), Italy (2018), Sweetland (2020 & 2021) and Romania (2023).

**Topics :** Papers are solicited on topics related with Medical and Service Robotics, including but not limited to: Design of medical devices • Kinematics and Dynamics for medical robotics • Exoskeletons and prostheses • Anthropomorphic hands • Therapeutic robots and rehabilitation • Cognitive robots • Humanoid & Service robots • Assistive robots and elderly assistance • Surgical robots • Human-robot interfaces • Haptic devices • Medical treatments  
The Scientific Committee will select papers for presentation at the conference.

**Contributed Papers :** Original papers must be submitted in PDF format. Manuscript templates are available on the conference website. Only papers for which at least one author has registered for MeSRob2025 prior to final submission will be accepted for the conference and be included in the proceedings. Accepted papers will be published after the workshop by Springer in an edited book.

**Location :** The conference will be held in Poitiers, a classic French provincial city. Capital of the Poitou area of western France, and county-town of the Vienne department, it is a historic city that has conserved much of its old-world charm. The University of Poitiers is one of oldest university in France, founded in 1431. Nowadays, with 25% of the population who are students, Poitiers is considered as the 1st College Town in France.

**Accommodation :** Poitiers has a good hotel offer. There are several hotels close to the conference building and in the city outskirts. A list of recommended hotels can be indicated at the registered participants.
